At that point, I began to wise up. Today, I am so thankful to God for preserving me. After, picking up dog poop, damaging my relationship with my only sister and almost bleeding to death... I figured out that there was something wrong with what I was being taught.

Today, I attend a good church that teaches faith in God, but also teaches that His ways are higher than ours and we DO NOT know everything! I have seen miracles (my 3rd child was healed of a severe brain injury) but now they come when I submit to God, worship Him and cry out to Him... knowing that He does all things well and just knowing and believing that He loves us! I dont talk much about that phase of my Christian walk. I think I'm embarrassed by my own foolishness and now realize all that could have been lost.

I was arrogant during that time. I was not walking in His love and I actually felt very far from God. Now if I am confused or have a question about something I seek HIM and in His time He provides the understanding and the answer. I am so thankful to God for His faithfulness and love.
