I will be sharing this passages to see the analogy of the painting and the music.

1 Cor. 2:7 This wisdom is a mystery. it is hidden. we see in v.8 that the princes who were actually the Jewish leaders in Christ's day. if they knew what was happening they wouldn't crucify Jesus. Jesus was hidden in plane sight. Just read Ps.22. All those who read Ps. 22 will only see what they read. The natural man cannot know the deep secrets hidden there. If it is hidden from the Jew, it is hidden from all who don't have the Holy Spirit.

Only God in us can tell us the deep things of God. That is shown in v.10.

Carnal living preachers can only fabricate what scriptures mean and in many cases produce error or heresy.

To be taught the bible in a church will produce a educated people. They will think they are spiritual because they may be taught by a spiritual preacher. They identify with the message as they receive it in their minds. That is why it is said the word did not profit them because it was not mixed with faith.

The Holy Spirit is the only one who can quicken the word Rom. 10:17 faith comes by hearing, but faith has to come when hearing. simply hearing is not faith but faith comes by hearing and believing.

Now wisdom comes by faith. James 1:5. That is by the Holy Spirit. v.12 the word freely and the word liberally are very closely related. God gives wisdom freely and liberally. v.7 again, wisdom hidden in a mystery cannot come from man it has to come from God. see v.11.

v.9 eye has not seen or ear heard what God has prepared for them who love him. the point here is that what you read in the bible is all there is for those who haven't received the gift which shows these deeper wonders. I will explain--v.6 we speak wisdom to the perfect. The Holy Spirit is also to give the perfection which God requires. He is making the renewal of the inner man. He imparts to the true believer a wisdom not known to man. He removes the veil and illuminates the light of his wisdom and knowledge to us. It is called the truth. It is not scripture alone, but is confirmed by the scriptures.

In other words he tells by his voice. You are blessed if you understand my message but more blessed if you experience it.

The word of God is like a beautiful painting. But if you are blind you cannot see it. If you have a awesome song played on a instrument with great lyrics and your deaf, you cannot hear it. So if you have not received the Holy Spirit, you cannot have wisdom, tongues are just a noise without the interpretation. (or) somehow some manifestation must occur in God's providential timing.

My experience to give example to you.

One day while on the way to work, the anointing came upon me very strongly. I was hollering in tongues. I stopped and that was it. Then driving for 5 or more minutes, began to turn left. A car was behind the other cars and was not patient. Was in part of the lane already when I heard 4 barrels of her motor coming at me. Praise God she only tapped my vehicle. Then she lost control and kept moving forward in the grass on the opposite side of highway.

She did miss the bridge and turn upside down and go under water. I got out and ran to save but God froze me. You see I couldn't swim. Instantly 2 men jumped off the bridge. They brought her up alive lay her down and she is saying repeatedly oh God. I'll stop here and say, God prayed through me and saved her life.

Rom. 8:26 read this and see we don't always know what to pray for. The Spirit of God does.

I hope you see I am not condemning anyone but showing that with this tremendous gift we can have wisdom and marvelous prayers through us. thank you Holy Spirit in Jesus name.
