Old testament references to "the lowest parts of the pit" and "the sides of the pit" give one the impression that there are different "levels", but if memory serves me, the teaching on the intermediate state (hades/sheol) focused on the non-physical aspects of this realm/state, which would lead us to conclude that such references were not actually meant to be taken literally. Anyway, that was how I took it. I probably need to pull out the theology book to make sure I got it right!
