You may want to browse for it in the library for free. that is if you are error conscience and get under the blood. that is so not to pick up deceiving spirits that may have other things in secret to do against you.

the main misunderstanding is that Messiah only means anointed one. remember anti-Christ is not anointed, that only comes by the Holy Spirit, it is referred also to oil, there are many fine line texts that don't say specific words. including what was translated to English from Hebrew.

Hagee is basically using a fine print word usage to say the bible doesn't really say that (game). it is also difficult to show people the error of J.D.S. they are wrestling the scriptures to their own destruction. if you could go beyond the thing they have heard that they hold fast to. which is a strong delusion, they would allow you to comment.

that is why all must be trained by a perfect God who will tell them when they are ready to teach or preach.

not to confuse mistakes with error. people can make mistakes, but a well trained person won't bring forth error. it is important for a continual fellowship with God to be in a position to be told-don't teach that today it is not correct.

sometimes we are not hearing correctly. those who teach error say they hear from God and their source is of him. the question is are they willing to answer to God for their mistakes. that is a big detourant from loose atitudes without huimble conviction that --I have to answer to God for all I say and do. scripture says every one must give account for the things they do Rom. 14:12

am feeling conviction right now. to explain. am not in trouble but feel God in my heart saying that all of us ,me included must be careful to be accountable.

that is a blessing not a problem. I appreciate God doing that in my heart, it is humbling and I like that feeling of personal care to keep me right. Hope that my experience here is understood and a blessing.
